Polio Immunization Program

04th November – 14th November 2026

Day 1: Delhi Arrival: – 04th November 2026 | Wednesday

Welcome to India! Arrival by international flight **TBC**. Upon arrival in Delhi, you will be met and transferred to your hotel. Overnight in Delhi. *Meal (-)*

Day 2: Delhi: – 05th November 2026 | Thursday

After morning breakfast, you will enjoy the full day sightseeing of Old & New Delhi including Jama Masjid (India's largest Mosque), Raj Ghat, Rickshaw ride in busy Chandni Chowk, Qutub Minar, Bangla Sahab Gurdwara, & India gate. Back to hotel and relax.

Overnight in Delhi. *Meal – Breakfast, Lunch*

Day 3: Delhi – Agra: – 06th November 2026 | Friday

After checkout from hotel and transfer to Agra by Road. Upon arrival in Agra, lunch with local medical authorities. Further we will go to designated area in village/urban area of Agra City to perform **Polio Awareness Rally** by distributing Flyers/pamphlets which mention the prevention and safety from Polio. Personalized club banners, caps & other important material will be supplied. Back to hotel and relax.

Overnight in Agra. *Meals – Breakfast, Lunch*





Day 4: Agra: – 07th November 2026 | Saturday | Polio Immunization

Today is the event for which we have been waiting – participation in the eradication of polio. We will be gathered at designated Local Community Center where we will be assigned to near vaccination stations.

There you will accompany with volunteers, doctor and Rotarians who helps you to give two drops of Polio Vaccine to children's up to the age of 5 years. Later have opportunity to go door to door for giving polio drops.

Lunch and cultural activities to be held in Vishwa Bharti School.

In evening Dinner and Drinks – Hosted by Agra Rotarians and Family members **(TBC)**.
Overnight in Agra. *Meals – Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner*

Day 5: Agra (Diwali Celebration): – 08th November 2026 | Sunday

Rise early to see the magnificent **Taj Mahal** at dawn. Commenced by Emperor Shah Jahan in 1631 and completed in 1653, it was dedicated to his beloved second wife, Mumtaz Mahal, who tragically died in childbirth. Enter through the West gate with its arch framing and revealing the beauty of the Taj within.

Take time to marvel at the Taj's unique and stunning symmetry, and the exquisite pearly marble, bathed in the pink light of dawn. Explore many perspectives from the platforms, pavilions and gardens around the main tomb, and the marble walls decorated with a myriad of semi-precious stones in the 'pietra dura' inlay work. Later, return to your hotel for a late breakfast. Further tour **Agra's imposing fort** on the banks of the holy Yamuna River. Built by Mughal Emperor Akbar in 1565, it was also home to Emperor Shah Jahan, who built the Taj Mahal and was later imprisoned here by his son.





Enjoy lunch (included – A South Indian Treat). Also visit a marble-inlay workshop, to see the intricate work and unique skill which goes into each finely detailed piece of marble inlay, using a variety of beautiful semi-precious stones. Evening Enjoy Diwali celebration with locals in Agra. Overnight in Agra. *Meals – Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner*

Day 6: Agra to Ranthambore (Tiger Reserve): – 09th November 2026 | Monday

Morning after breakfast and transfer to Fatehpur Sikri magnificent palace built by Akbar on mountains of Sikri and named it "Fatehpur Sikri". After Lunch (included) board Super-Fast Train (**KOTA JANSHTBDI 12060 @02:50 – 05:15 PM**) from Bharatpur to Ranthambore. Sit back and relax on the express train. Enjoy the scenic vistas of northern India as you are transported door-to-door in just a few hours. Experience the quickest way to travel in India, as small villages, and plantations whizz by. On arrival, check-in and relax. Enjoy dinner while enjoying jungle themed activities at the hotel. Overnight in Ranthambore. *Meals included – Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner*

Ranthambore – The Tiger Reserve

This former hunting ground of Jaipur's maharajas has been under the protection of Project Tiger since the early 1970s and it attracts nature-lovers from around the world eager to spot the endangered and mighty Bengal tigers. The park including the leopard, hyena, jackal, sloth bear, crocodile and spotted deer as well as countless birds. Experience the thrill of a jeep safari as you embark on a game journey from the Aravalli's Mountains to the Vindhya Range in search of the elusive tiger. Visit historic Ranthambore Fort which is over 1,000 years old and offers breath-taking views of the park from its hill-top setting.

Day 7: Ranthambore (Tiger Reserve) | 10th November 2026, Tuesday

This morning, embark on a private jeep safari (included) through the rugged national park in search of the much sought-after Bengal tiger, monkeys, jackal and more. Return for breakfast. Re visit game park in afternoon (2nd Trip, shared canter safari included) again accompanied by naturalist in Jungles of Ranthambhore as one of the few preserves were nocturnal, camera-shy tigers may be seen in (sunset) during feeding. Evening on leisure with local cultural activities at resort.

Overnight in Ranthambore. *Meals included – Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner*

Day 8: Ranthambore to Jaipur (appx 4 hrs by road) | 11th November 2026, Wednesday

Early Morning Canter/jeep safari (3rd Trip, OWN), back to resort for breakfast, relax and checkout and transfer to Jaipur. Once you arrive in Jaipur, you'll get transferred to your hotel. If you want, you can enjoy a leisurely walk around. Overnight in Jaipur. *Meals included – Breakfast & Lunch*





Day 9: Jaipur: - 12th November 2026 | Thursday

Begin today by driving by admire the striking façade of the Hawa Mahal, the Palace of the Winds, designed for the royal ladies to watch the processions and daily life of

the city without being seen themselves – a result of the strict “purdah” which was observed until the 20th century. The impressive Amber Fort, around twenty minutes’ drive outside Jaipur itself, is our main site for the morning This imposing fort is situated atop a mountain in the midst of stark and dramatic landscape a date back to 1592. You will drive up to the fort by jeep (elephant ride is also available at no extra cost) and explore the various buildings. Marvel at the beautifully painted traditional Mughal doorways and the remarkable Sheesh Mahal with its thousands of mirrored tiles.

Walk down from the fort and return to downtown Jaipur to explore shops for Rajasthani handicrafts in Jaipur’s where jewellery, fabrics, lamps, bangles, bags are world famous. After lunch (included) at local restaurant, enjoy a visit to City Palace & walk at the local market. Return to hotel and relax.

Overnight at Jaipur. *Meals included – Breakfast & Lunch.*

Day 10: Jaipur – Neemrana: - 13th November 2026 | Friday

Morning after breakfast transfer to Neemrana by road, on arrival check in hotel and relax. Neemrana Fort is a 15th-century hilltop fort in Rajasthan, restored and converted into a famous heritage hotel, known as the Neemrana Fort-Palace. It is a major tourist attraction because of its royal architecture, panoramic views of the Aravalli hills, historic charm, cultural events and adventure activities.

Overnight in Neemrana. *Meals included – Breakfast*



Day 11: Neemrana – Delhi – Depart: – 14th November 2026 | Saturday

Morning enjoys Camel Ride & Village Walk. Later check out & transfer to Delhi by drive, on arrival check in Aerocity hotel for Wash & Change (06PM to 09PM). Further Check-out & transfer to Delhi International Airport to board flight **TBC** for onward destinations. *Meals included – Breakfast & Dinner*

E-Tourist Visa (India)

India's e-Tourist Visa is an online travel authorization available to citizens of eligible countries. It allows foreign nationals to visit India for tourism, short-term medical treatment or casual business visits. The application process is fully digital with approvals typically granted within 72 hours. The visa is valid for durations of 30 days (double entry), 1 year or 5 years (multiple entries). It provides a fast, convenient and efficient way to travel to India.

Application Process:

1. Visit below official Indian e-Visa website to apply.

2. Upload your passport bio page (PDF, 10 KB–300 KB) and photo (JPEG, 10 KB–1 MB; light/white background, head centered, no shadows).
3. Pay the non-refundable fee—varies by duration.
4. Receive ETA by email, print it and carry it during travel.
5. Arrive in India via one of the designated **28 airports** or **5 seaports**; e-Visa applies only at these entry points. Biometric data (photo and fingerprints) will be collected upon arrival.
6. Exit may be through any authorized immigration checkpoint.
